An error in the transcription of the azimuth values onto the standard result tapes exists for the above runs of UP-1-A. Only pointing directions away from vertical are affected. A value of -295.46 appears on the result tapes (for the off-vertical parts of the experiments) when in fact, in all cases, the true azimuth was -0.09 degrees, ie. To the north. This has no effect on other parameters on the tapes; for example the latitudes and longitudes were calculated using the correct azimuth values.
